CABINETS

Kitchen, bath, countertops (stone or formica)



FLOORING

New, full boxes of tile, linoleum, and wood flooring, new carpet, area rugs (may be gently used)



APPLIANCES

Clean and working appliances including stoves, washers, dryers, refrigerators, etc.



TOOLS

All power tools (Guards, batteries, and chargers must be included.)



FURNITURE

Clean sofas, chairs, tables, dressers, beds, bookshelves, etc.



HARDWARE

New electrical hardware, non-metal plumbing, complete low flow toilets, sinks, tubs, etc



HOME GOODS

Dishes, cookware, utensils, baskets, knick knacks, artwork



BUILDING MATERIALS

Plywood, sheet rock, new insulation, new duct work, doors, unused lumber (6'+), trim (6'+), brick/block, fencing, unopened paint, framed windows, roofing materials



LIGHTING

Working light fixtures, lamp shades, assembled ceiling fans, boxed light bulbs
